Worship Responsibilities

- Identify, invite, train and empower volunteers to be a part of worship and creative arts ministries.
- Create an anointed, excellent environment in all worship services by constant evaluation and systematic improvements.
- Oversee all volunteers and any paid staff in each of these environments.
- Use technology, media and production in all areas to supplement the worship environment.
- Meet with key staff/volunteers on a regular basis to evaluate and improve worship & creative arts.
- Manage planningcenteronline.com. Ensure that materials for the band are online at the appropriate time.

- Manage the scheduling of musicians and worship leaders for weekend services.
- Manage band rehearsals.
- Ensure that the band is able to play songs with excellence.
- Develop and manage the worship budget. Ensure that financial procedures are followed in your department.
- Plan and arrange the Sunday set with Ableton or other playback device.
- Train and equip volunteer worship leaders to lead and encourage the congregation.

Production Responsibilities

- Communicate regularly with the Production Coordinator to ensure all elements for the Worship service are ready.
- Coordinate with the Production Coordinator to plan for special services such as; Christmas Eve, Easter, Worship nights, funerals etc.
